Special Meeting

March 27, 2024 at 7:15 pm

Mayor Ken Schoon called a special meeting of the Goose Lake City council to order at 7:15 p.m. Council members present were Mike Mattis, Mike Schmidt, Josh Spain and Matt Cain. Absent: Darrin Farrell.

M/S: Mattis-Schmidt moved to approve the Agenda as presented. On roll call, carried unanimously.

Mayor Schoon opened the Public Hearing for the Proposed Property Tax Levy for fiscal year 2024-2025.
