

**CITY OF GOOSE LAKE
CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
May 21, 2026**

Mayor Ken Schoon called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Council Members present included: Josh Spain, Maggie Kenney, Bre Hudson, Matt Cain by phone, and Mike Schmidt by phone.

M/S: Spain/Schmidt moved to adopt the agenda as presented. On roll call, carried unanimously.

M/S: Kenney/Cain moved to approve the consent agenda. On roll call, carried unanimously. The consent agenda includes minutes of the April 16, 2026 regular meeting, minutes of the April 27, 2026 special meeting, the treasurer's report, financial reports, and the following new bills.

Expenses were: General \$30453.28, Insurance \$5764.41, RUT \$1652.26, County Contributions \$0, Local Option Sales Tax \$0, Fire Sinking Fund \$0, ARPA \$0, Water \$12715.45, Water Sinking Fund \$0, Water Trust \$0.00, Sewer \$20944.53, Sewer Sinking Fund \$0, Garbage \$1922.04. Revenues were: General \$28093.20, Insurance \$6959.84, RUT \$1943.64, County Contribution \$2104.73, Local Option Sales Tax \$3003.49, ARPA \$0, Capital Projects Fire Sinking Fund \$0, Water \$6308.00, Water Trust \$0, Water Sinking Fund \$0, Sewer \$8576.28, Sewer Sinking Fund \$0, Garbage \$2152.00.

The monthly Sheriff's report was sent in by Sheriff Bill Greenwalt. There were 70:28 total hours logged for the month; 44 calls for service; 4 citations or warnings; 0 cases reported.

Water Superintendent Marty Jahn was present and said that it has been quiet. He has done 6 locates. Sewer Superintendent Seth Ashpole was present and reported that he did discharge early to catch up the drainage of the lagoon.

Chief Firefighter Cain was present and said he went to a Fire Chief's meeting on April 29th. The brush truck is finally complete. Their BBQ Contest will be June 20th and will move it to the Fire Department/City Hall because of the lagoon work. They will do a breakfast that morning.

Dwain Schroeder has been doing some work down at the park. Joy Soenksen got the restrooms cleaned and stated flowers will be planted soon.

Marc Ruden was present and gave an update on the lagoon project. The supplier for the liner is experiencing higher costs and can't honor their bid. There is solid bedrock under part of the old lagoon and will need to slightly modify the design.

Council discussed with Marc Ruden the differences in white vs. black lagoon liners. M/S: Spain/Hudson made a motion to approve Change Order No. 1 for WWTF Improvements 2025 on the white liner. On roll call, carried unanimously.

M/S: Hudson/Kenney moved to approve Contract Payment No. 1 for \$441,592.50 for WWTF Improvements 2025. On roll call, carried unanimously.

Council discussed the Eastern Iowa Regional Housing Authority and Ken Schoon and Bre Hudson volunteered. M/S: Kenney/Spain moved to approve Resolution 9509: Resolution Appointing Commissioners to the Eastern Iowa Regional Housing Authority. On roll call, carried unanimously.

M/S: Spain/Kenney moved to table the rent for daycare until the September meeting. On roll call, carried unanimously.

M/S: Hudson/Kenney moved to approve Manatts do blacktop repair. On roll call, carried unanimously.

Clerk Beeck informed council of the last two rental dates in May for the community center.

Council discussed the nuisance properties. One property has started to pick up their debris pile and another property needs to mow- clerk will send a letter.

M/S: Spain/Hudson moved to close School Street for the Goose Lake Fire Department BBQ Contest on June 20, 2026. On roll call, carried unanimously.

Council discussed the large item pickup from AT Disposal. Citizens will need to contact Clerk and she will keep track of it. Mayor Schoon thanked Councilmember Schmidt and Clerk Beeck on their work with the insurance company and getting the workman's compensation fixed. Clerk Beeck will order an Iowa flag for our flag pole.

M/S: Spain/Kenney moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:03 pm. On roll call, carried unanimously. The next regular meeting will be held on June 18, 2026 at 7:00 pm at City Hall in Goose Lake.
