## UTILITY CUSTOMERS

**Please keep your outside meter area cleaned** for Paula so she can get a good read from your Meter. **REMEMBER:**

**You will be charged a \$15.00 fee for paying your bill after the due date on the 20<sup>th</sup>.** If the 20<sup>th</sup> falls on a Saturday or Sunday you will have until the following Monday. If 20<sup>th</sup> falls on a Friday the payment is due by 5:00 pm that day. **Any payments received on the 21<sup>st</sup> or later are subject to the \$15.00 late fee!!** **REMINDER** **If you do not receive your utility bill by the 4<sup>th</sup> Or 5<sup>th</sup> of the month, please contact the City Clerk.**

## PLANNING ON BUILDING?

The City Code of Ordinances **requires** any new structures be approved **prior to** construction by Council through a building permit process. The cost of the permit is \$25.00 and the application can be obtained by calling City Hall at 577-2300. This does not include remodels, roofs or cement. It does include add-ons to a house or garage or a free standing shed or other building.

## CITY OF GOOSE LAKE RESIDENTS

There will be a city-wide clean-up done on October 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. This is for residents only. The dumpsters will be located in the City Hall parking lot. Please **DO NOT** set items outside of the dumpsters. If they do not fit inside, take them to the landfill on your own. The County Landfill will not accept brush, trees, paint cans, batteries, tires or appliances. **Do Not** put these items in the dumpsters.
