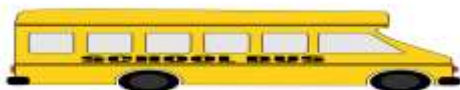

UTILITY CUSTOMERS

REMEMBER:

You will be charged a **\$15.00 fee** for paying your bill **after the due date on the 20th**. If the 20th falls on a Saturday or Sunday you will have until the following Monday. If 20th falls on a Friday the payment is due by 5:00 pm that day.

Any payments received on the 21st or later are subject to the \$15.00 late fee!! **REMINDER**

If you do not receive your utility bill by the 4th Or 5th of the month, please contact the City Clerk.

If you haven't had your endpoint

installed: Council has approved a fine of \$100.00 per resident that fails to comply with getting an endpoint installed by January 31, 2023. Then a door hanger will be on your door to notify you of a 24-hour shut-off of your water for failure to comply.
