Mayor Ken Schoon called the regular monthly meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Council Members present included: Jan Bormann, Josh Spain, Rhonda Lorenzen, and Darrin Farrell. Absent: Mike Mattis. M/S, Spain-Bormann moved to adopt the agenda as presented. On roll call, carried unanimously. M/S, Farrell-Lorenzen moved to approve the consent agenda. On roll call, carried unanimously. Expenses November were General \$4747.76, RUT \$826.61, County Contributions \$0.00, Local Option Sales Tax \$500.00, ARPA \$0.00, Water \$5237.64, SRF Sinking Fund \$883.75, Water Trust \$0.00, Sewer \$6309.68, Sewer Sinking Fund \$0.00, Garbage \$1857.43. Revenues for November were General \$6953.83, RUT \$1423.47, County Contribution \$0.00, Local Option Sales Tax \$5902.49, ARPA \$0.00, Water \$5732.82, Water Trust \$0.00, SRF Sinking Fund \$3000.00, Sewer \$4001.66, Sewer Sinking Fund \$1500.00 Garbage \$2007.60.

The monthly Sheriff's report was sent in by Sheriff Bill Greenwalt. There were 54:26 total hours logged for the month; 27 calls for service; 4 citations or warnings; 1 case reported. Marty Jahn, Water Operator, presented a report on the Water Department stating the monthly reports and tests have been sent to the DNR. Jahn also stated there were no locates during the month, one water shut-off is still off for non-payment. There was no report on the Wastewater plant.

Fire Chief Kevin Cain sent a report on the activities of the Fire Department. Council Member Farrell presented that report. Since the middle of November, the Fire Department responded to 5 calls requiring firemen to respond and 3 EMS calls in or around Goose Lake. Farrell noted the pumper truck that was in for repairs has now been returned and was used the very same night it was returned to aid the Charlotte Fire Department. Farrell added that not all of the repairs have been completed on the pumper truck, there will be additional parts added when they arrive. Elections were held within the Fire Department with the following results: Chief Kevin Cain, Asst. Chief Matt Cain, 2nd Asst. Chief Darrin Farrell, Lt. Adam Cain and Lt. Alex Sellnau.

Council Member Jan Bormann stated the Senior Citizens met for their monthly card playing session. There were 22 participants playing cards. Bormann handed a card to the Mayor from the Senior Citizens. Mayor Schoon read the card aloud and accepted the \$75.00 from the Goose Lake Senior Citizens for their use of the Community Center throughout the year. Ken Schoon finished replacing light bulbs at city hall. Mayor Schoon also stated Dwaine Schroeder has put fence posts in the park and he will put up a snow fence.

Judy Buntemeyer was in the audience to address the Mayor and Council on the use of cameras and recording devices by the city, on city property.

Mayor Schoon stated he called and left messages for Jerry Giddings regarding the repair of a fire hydrant on O'Brian Street. Mr. Giddings had previously worked on this hydrant and it is currently not working. Mayor Schoon stated that Mr. Giddings has not got back with him yet. Marty Jahn stated he spoke with Troy Sheldon from Utility Equipment Company and he may be interested in looking at the hydrant.

M/S, Farrell-Spain moved to approve the 2022 City Council Meeting list, noting that additional meetings may be required for work sessions or projects. On roll call, carried unanimously.

In other, Mayor Schoon stated he has been working with Marty Jahn regarding the request for additional funds for work done doing locates, water shut-offs and water main breaks. Council was given the information to think over and the item will be re-visited at the next Council meeting as an agenda item.

M/S, Bormann-Lorenzen moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:45 pm. On roll call, carried unanimously. The next regular meeting will be held on January 20, 2022 at 7:00 pm at City Hall in Goose Lake.
