

GOOSE LAKE COUNCIL MINUTES

Special Meeting

May 22, 2025

Mayor Ken Schoon called a special meeting of the Goose Lake City council to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members present were Mike Schmidt, Matt Cain and Darrin Farrell. Absent: Josh Spain and Mike Mattis

Mayor Schoon opened the Public Hearing for the Proposed Amended FY 2025 City Budget. There were no comments received or heard regarding proposed Amended FY 2025 City Budget. Motion to closed the public hearing by Schmidt, seconded by Cain. On roll call, carried unanimously.

Motion by Farrell, seconded by Cain to approve Resolution No. 9488 entitled, Resolution to Approve Amended City Budget for July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. On roll call, carried unanimously.

Motion by Schmidt, seconded by Farrell to approve Resolution No. 9486 entitled, Resolution to Lien Property for Unpaid Utilities – O'Brian St. On roll call, carried unanimously.

Motion by Cain, seconded by Farrell to approve Resolution No. 9487 entitled, Resolution to Lien Property for Unpaid Utilities – Public St. On roll call vote, carried unanimously.

The City of Goose Lake received two bids for the garbage and recycling services RFP Haulers request. Bids were due by 5:00 pm on May 22, 2025. City Clerk opened the bids. The first bid was from Allied Services, aka Republic Services; the second bid was from AT Disposal.

Motion by Cain, seconded by Schmidt to accept the lower bid from AT Disposal to begin on November 1, 2025 and continue through October 31, 2026 and each year after until October 31, 2030. On roll call, carried unanimously. Residents will receive new carts for both garbage and recycling at the end of October 2025. More information will be given to residents in the coming months.

Motion by Schmidt, seconded by Cain to send property owner in Texas a certified letter regarding the nuisances existing on the O'Brian Street property. On roll call, carried unanimously.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:53 pm on a motion by Farrell, seconded by Schmidt. Roll call vote, carried unanimously.
