April 6 Assist Charlotte with EMS call	1 paramedic/6 firemen
April 7 Monthly training meeting	6 firemen attended
April 7 Assist Mile with structure fire	7 firemen responded
April 8 Assist Preston with grass fire	8 firemen responded
April 9 Assist Charlotte with fire	9 firemen responded
April 11 Assist Charlotte with EMS call	1 paramedic, 1 EMT, 2 firemen

Additionally, three members completed their EMS course and one has already passed their required testing and is a registered EMR. The other two are working on scheduling for their testing. The fire department recently received a \$2500 grant from the Lincolnway Foundation. The money will help go toward the money needed to replace one set of gear. One pair of pants and a coat costs \$3600.
